Fundraising and the Law

- All printed material used to persuade people to give or pay money to a hospice must state that the institution is a registered charity, quoting the Registered Charity No. 298627.
- Public collections require a local authority permit. Private properties require permission from their owners in addition to the local authority permit.
- Young people under 16 years old shall not collect money in public or house-to-house.
- Money must be collected in sealed boxes or tins. Money used for a specific purpose can only be used for that purpose.
- Lotteries, raffles and tombolas are governed by the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 and the National Lottery Act 1993.
- Public events must not breach public order. The local authority and police must be notified of all public activities and will give advice about what is permissible and not permissible.
